

ACCESSIBILITY POLICY

The All About Pets Show is proud to be an accessible event. The following policies have been developed to balance the interest of all concerned.

A. Service Dogs

While there is a general policy of not allowing guests' pets at the Show at any time, our Accessibility Policy does allow trained and accredited service dogs and their owner(s) access to the show. In consideration of the health and welfare of the service dogs, our guests to the show and all of our valuable show participants (dogs, cats, birds and reptiles), service dogs are permitted under specified conditions and in most areas of the Show.

Conditions and Procedure:

1. The following documentation is required and is to be presented to the identified ticket booth prior to admission, to permit access for a service dog to the show:
 - a. Accreditation documentation by a recognized Assistance Dogs International program or equivalent. Proper harness or jacket/vest on the service dog. As per show policy, only working dogs (not including retired, trainee and companion dogs) are permitted at the Show.
 - b. Proof of current vaccinations against rabies, canine distemper, hepatitis, leptospirosis, parovirus and CAV-2.
2. To respect the health and safety of all, Show exhibits should be approached with sensitivity and caution to give others animals a chance to react to the presence of a service dog. For everyone's welfare, if an animal appears distressed or agitated, the dog should be immediately moved back or, if necessary, away from the exhibit completely.
3. If the dog is barking or causing a disturbance for the animals or other guests, the guest and accompanying service dog may be required to leave the area or the Show site.
4. The owner is responsible to "stoop and scoop".
5. Visitors are not permitted in the Show service and non-public areas.

Show Management is available on site and may be contacted at the Information desk or any of the ticket booths.

B. Wheelchairs

A limited number of wheelchairs are available at the Main Entrance ticket booths on a first come/first serve basis. You will be required to leave a driver's license or credit card with the ticket agent.
